We are all excited about the year ahead and are committed to helping all students reach their potential. Being a senior student holds much responsibility at Pimpama State School. In light of this, this year, we look forward to encouraging your child towards being the absolute best that they can be, both academically and socially. Students will be required to set an example for all members of the school community, in regards to uniform, behaviour, work ethic, attendance and punctuality. We have reviewed the following expectations with the Year 6 students:

Students are expected to:

- Complete expected assignments and homework on time.
- Have a parent or carer write a note should they be absent or not be able to complete work.

Homework:

Homework will begin in Week 2. Please write a note if for any reason your child cannot complete homework. Your classroom teacher will provide the students with further information. Homework will be due on Tuesdays.

Subject Areas:

This term in **English** we will be focussing on Narrative structure, characterisation and humorous plots in the Short Story Genre. Students will be writing their own humorous narrative as an assessment. You can assist your child in English by encouraging them to read either books, magazines, newspapers, or by using the on-line Reading Eggs program.

READING is the key!

Mathematics. Students will be consolidating knowledge in Number by investigating prime and composite numbers. They will be introduced to factor trees and **it is extremely important students know or learn their tables.** In Fractions, students will be comparing and ordering both number and decimal fractions. There will be a focus on Timetabling and a relevant assessment. Remember **Mathletics on line** is a valuable learning tool.

In **Science**, students will be exploring "Electrical Circuitry" which will be linked to the learning in Digital Technology. Students will also be completing a Physics unit with Ms Tracey Sidoti

In Hass **History**, students will study the foundation of Australia as a nation.

In Art, students will be creating Picasso style portraits.

In **Health**, we will be using the Pimpama Social Skills program called "Focus Forty" which addresses the Pimpama Values. Students will also be studying Cyber Safety, use the Six Thinking Hat to guide their learning.

Digital Technology/Coding is preparing students to work with computers and make programmes.

There will be assignments and related assessments for all of the subject areas and students will be given the due dates and ample time to complete tasks.

iPads:

iPads will not be required at school until Monday Week 3. The permission forms will again be required. Students without iPads will be provided equal opportunity for learning.
